Youth Matters – Past, present and future.

As Parish Youth Worker, I am truly delighted with how far we have come in such a short space of time regarding Youth Matters at Our Lady and All Saints. I wrote recently to everyone as part of the Parish Magazine – copies of which are still available if you are yet to see one. However this very much looked at what we have done in the past, this time I would like to look forward to the future and let everyone know what is coming up.

This weekend we have 4 Altar servers attending the first ever diocesan Altar Servers retreat – "Called to Serve". This is an exciting opportunity for our young servers to receive world class catechesis from Jimmy Mitchell, a chance for interactive sessions surrounding vocations, outdoor activities like mountain biking and abseiling along with unique sessions surrounding Eucharistic adoration and procession. I am sure they will all have a fantastic time, and I am thoroughly looking forward to journeying with them.

As well as this we also have 3 sixth formers attending the retreat as service team to experience first-hand what it is like to work as part of a mission team, leading through prayer, example, and hard graft. I hope they will enjoy the experience and take the next step in their journey of faith by joining the mission team at Kenelm Youth trust, something I cannot recommend enough having enjoyed many years as a volunteer and member of staff with Kenelm Youth Trust.

It is also my pleasure to be inviting our young people on many more events towards the end of this academic year. Next Wednesday members of our youth group will be attending a well-deserved trip to "Flip out" in Oldbury where they have the chance to get involved with the different elements including the trampoline park and adrenaline filled slides and jumps. The cost of this is just £12 and I would like to remind parents and carers to return the consent forms to myself or Fr Philip as soon as possible.

Members of the Youth group have also been invited to the "It's A Knockout" event run by Kenelm Youth trust. This event is a competition weekend against other youth groups from across the Archdiocese of Birmingham. We will be camping overnight and be involved in a site wide game of hunted, a range of wonderful games, BBQ evening meal and outdoor mass. Once again please can parents and carers provide consent for this using the link provided and let me know once that has been done. The cost of this is a heavily subsidised £32 made payable to KYT through a separate payment link. If you would like to know more about this, please get in touch.

I am delighted that those young people from our parish who are of High school age have also taken a big step forward in their faith by joining up for Summer Camp at Alton Castle. We currently have 8 places full; meaning that I have a further 2 spaces available should anyone like to join. Summer camp is truly the highlight of the Youth calendar in the diocese and further information can be found at https://www.kenelmyouthtrust.org.uk/summer-camp-2024.html. Camp includes a day of messy games, a day at Alton Towers theme park, a secret activity to be announced soon, outdoor activities, daily prayer, and Mass along with amazing talks and chances for the sacrament of reconciliation- It is truly "THE BEST CAMP EVER."

The KYT RECONNECT day is back on Saturday May 11th. This is a day to give parishes the opportunity to bring young people together at Alton Castle and then to journey with them to the exciting and exhilarating Alton Towers. We will then return to the castle for our Mass of thanksgiving together followed by a KYT BBQ! We are subsidising this day for parishes to RECONNECT with young people. Therefore, the cost is just £30pp. If you would like to know any more about this day, please get in touch.

I would also like to remind everyone about the sleepover fundraising event in the parish centre on Thursday 28th March until Friday 29th March. Please ensure that your child has eaten before arriving for the start of our event which is the Maundy Thursday Mass at 19:30. The children will then lead the readings and offertory at Mass before coming over to the parish centre for an evening full of fun and prayer. The evening will include options for a film night, youth group and team building activities. We will finish with hot chocolate and night prayer all together before heading in to separate gendered rooms to sleep.
