REPORT OF CHUCHES TOGETHER IN STOURBRIDGE - 2024 As part of our Parish Synodal discernment it was felt that Community Involvement is an important aspect of our Mission. Being a member of CTIS and making friends/joining in/working with other Christians, is an excellent way to achieve this. There are 15 Churches in the group including the United Lye Church who recently joined. Gigmill and New Road have now become Stourbridge Methodist Church but retaining separate buildings and Services.

There are a number of shared projects which benefit the community, and volunteers to help or be prayer partners, are always most welcome. Replenish Foodbank, the Life Centre Debt Advice and Street Pastors on Saturday nights are long-standing ways in which CTIS serves the people of Stourbridge. Our parish and schools have been very generous in their donations to the Foodbank. There is also co-operation in supporting Fair Trade and Christian Aid with various fund-raising, information and prayer initiatives. A Repair Cafe meets every month in St. Thomas's Church Hall.

Throughout the year there are opportunities for worship, discussion and study together, hosted by different Churches but open to all. The year begins with The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity in January and the (Women's) World Day of Prayer at the beginning of March. During Lent several study courses were held, again free for anyone to join in. The Good Friday Walk of Witness this year began in OLAS and ended at the Clock Tower with music from our Music Group. There was a record attendance with respectful silence during the walk. CTIS organised an Election Hustings in June and a Taize Service took place in July. Several listed Church buildings, including our own, were open for guided visits during the September Heritage Week, although attendance at ours was very poor. An interesting discussion on Prison Visiting was held at the Quaker Meeting House in October and a CTIS representative laid a wreath on the War Memorial at the Remembrance Service in Mary Stevens Park. The final event of the year is Carol Singing in the Crown Centre accompanied again by our Music Group.

PRAY – FAST -GIVE

LENT is 40 days from Ash Wednesday concluding with the Triduum (the three days) Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil.

The 40 days help us to identity with Jesus, who spent 40 days in fasting and prayer in the desert before beginning his public ministry. It is a time for spiritual reflection and renewal of our commitment to Christ, who gave up his life for us.

The Gospel mentions three ways - **Prayer** (God), **Fasting** (Self) and **Almsgiving** (Others) – making time for God each day, - a time for Prayer, Weekday Mass, Stations of the Cross, Spiritual Reading, the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Reconciliation, Meditation, Serving and Helping those in Need, the Foodbank.


